THIS YEAR:	<p>These are the units/topics/vocabulary I expect to cover this year: numbers, days/months, colors, introducing yourself, describing people, asking about someone, describing your surroundings and school and family, telling time, talking about where you go, how you spend your time, what foods you eat for breakfast and lunch</p> <p>Throughout the year, you will be working with several different classmates on various projects and activities. ABSENTEE POLICY	<p>If you are absent for a class due to lesson, illness or field trip- it is YOUR responsibility to make up all the work done during class. If you miss one class then you have <u>eight school days</u> to get caught up. After that, you <u>will</u> receive a zero for assignments and quizzes cannot be made up. Any cuts will result in referral and work may or may not be available for make up, at my discretion.</p>

POLICIES

Electronics:

All electronics being used during class will be taken and turned in to the appropriate administrator as per the school policy found in the agenda book.

Class Cuts:

If you are in school, you are expected in class. If you do not report, it is a cut and will be referred.

Food:

I allow food in class but you will not leave class to get it. If you bring a snack and clean up after yourself that is okay. There is a pail for cans and bottles. If I am cleaning up after your class, no one will be allowed to have food.

Lateness:

Late arrivals to class without a pass will be monitored. Every two lates will receive a detention with me. Chronic lateness will result in a referral.

Behavior:

While in class, you are expected to behave in accordance with school rules and policy. Everyone is entitled to learn without interruption or distraction. You will respect and honor this right.

Bathroom/Hall Passes:

You must ask and get your agenda book signed by Miss Clegg. One student out at a time.

GRADING

Throughout the quarter, you will earn points on various graded things. Your grade will be determined by adding the total number of points you earned divided by the total number of possible quarter points. This year I will be using snapgrades.com- you will receive log in information so you can monitor your grade!

Here's a basic rundown of the activities you will earn points on:

- **Homework** (50 pts each, 2 or 3 per quarter)
- **Quizzes** (30-70 pts each, 5-6 per quarter)
- **Tests** (100-150 pts each, 1-2 per quarter)
- **Projects** (20-100 pts each, 1-3 per quarter)
- **Classwork** (100-250 pts per quarter)
- **Participation Calendar** (50-75 pts per quarter)
- **Notebook Checks** (up to 40 pts per quarter)

PARTICIPATION CALENDAR

You will have a participation calendar with you every day. You can earn participation checks by: answering or asking a question in class, getting an answer right on a listening activity or even winning a game! At the end of each month, you will total your checks. Each month, you can to earn up to 25 points for your grade!
